EDUCATIONAL EXPERIENCE

Young Artists' days are filled with a balance of shooting on location and in the field, lectures and critiques, demonstrations, editing, writing, computer workflow, and darkroom work, depending on the workshop. All of our instructors are inspiring industry professionals as well as experienced educators, and each works with a teaching assistant who provides additional support for their class.

CAMPUS LIFE

Counselors supervise the students 24 hours a day and help make group decisions about weekend activities like swimming, bowling, and hiking. All meals are eaten as a group. Parents can indicate any special dietary needs upon registration.

ACCOMMODATIONS

All Young Artists reside at a nearby residence (with four students to a room, gender-specific) located near our campus. The property is controlled by Maine Media Workshops and is used primarily by our Young Artists and their counselors.
